



This 7-day itinerary offers a blend of Nepal's cultural, historical, and natural beauty. Starting from Kathmandu, the journey takes you to Lumbini, the birthplace of Lord Buddha, followed by Chitwan National Park for an exciting wildlife experience. The tour then moves to Nagarkot for breathtaking mountain views before returning to Kathmandu via Bhaktapur Durbar Square and Swayambhunath Stupa. This trip is ideal for those interested in exploring Nepal's diverse landscapes and cultural heritage.

DAY 2

Lumbini

Upon arrival in Kathmandu, you will be greeted by the vibrant city life and rich cultural heritage. After checking into your hotel, spend the day exploring the local markets and getting accustomed to the city's pace. Visit the bustling neighborhood of Thamel, known for its guest houses, restaurants, and shops.

Begin the day early and drive to Lumbini, a journey that takes approximately 8 to 9 hours via the Prithivi Highway6. Along the way, enjoy the scenic views of the countryside and small towns. Upon arrival in Lumbini, check into your hotel and spend the evening relaxing. You can take a short stroll around the Lumbini Garden to get a glimpse of the area.

# DAY 3

## Lumbini -Chitwan

Spend the morning exploring Lumbini, visiting iconic sites such as the Maya Devi Temple, Ashoka Pillar, Bodi Tree, and the Monasteries Zone. After lunch, drive to Chitwan National Park, which takes about 3 to 4 hours. Check into your hotel and enjoy the sunset view from the Rapti River, followed by a cultural program by the Tharu community.

### DAY 4

#### Chitwan

Today, immerse yourself in the wildlife of Chitwan National Park. Engage in activities like an jeep ride, jungle walk, canoeing, and visit the Elephant Breeding Centre1. The park is home to diverse wildlife, including one-horned rhinos, gharails and Royal Bengal Tigers.

## DAY 5

# Chitwan -Nagarkot

After breakfast, drive to Nagarkot, a scenic hill station known for its stunning sunrise and mountain views. The journey takes about 7 to 8 hours, depending on traffic and road conditions. Check into your hotel and spend the evening enjoying the panoramic views of the Himalayas.

# DAY 6

Nagarkot -Bhaktapur -Kathmandu Begin the day early to catch the sunrise at Nagarkot. Then, drive back to Kathmandu, stopping at Bhaktapur Durbar Square to explore its ancient architecture and cultural significance. Continue to Swayambhunath Stupa, a sacred Buddhist site offering panoramic views of the city. Spend the evening shopping for souvenirs or exploring Kathmandu's nightlife.

#### DAY 7

Kathmandu -Departure Spend the morning at leisure, perhaps visiting any lastminute sights or shopping for souvenirs. Depart for the airport and head back home, bringing with you memories of Nepal's rich cultural heritage and natural beauty.
