



The Four City Tour in Nepal

10 Days 9 Nights



Explore Nepal's cultural, spiritual, and natural highlights: Kathmandu's temples, Chitwan's wildlife, Lumbini (Buddha's birthplace), Pokhara's lakes and mountains, and Patan/Swayambhunath before returning to Kathmandu.

DAY 2

Kathmandu -Chitwan Upon arrival in Kathmandu, you will be greeted at the airport and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure, allowing you to acclimate to the city's vibrant atmosphere. You can explore the nearby streets of Thamel, known for its shopping and dining options, or simply relax at your hotel.

Today, you will embark on a scenic drive to Chitwan National Park, a journey that typically takes about 5 to 6 hours. Along the way, you'll pass through picturesque landscapes and rural villages. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure, perhaps taking a stroll around the nearby area.

DAY 3

Chitwan

This day is dedicated to exploring Chitwan National Park. You will participate in a jungle safari, which may include activities like a jeep safari, and a canoe trip. The park is home to a diverse range of wildlife, including rhinos, tigers, and various bird species. In the evening, you might enjoy a cultural program by the local Tharu community.

DAY 4

Chitwan -Lumbini

After breakfast, you will drive to Lumbini, the birthplace of Lord Buddha. The journey takes about 4 hours, offering views of rural Nepal along the way. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and spend the rest of the day relaxing or exploring the local area.

DAY 5

Lumbini

Today, you will explore the sacred sites of Lumbini, including the Mayadevi Temple, Ashoka Pillar, and the Puskarini Pond. The area is also home to numerous monasteries built by different countries, showcasing a blend of architectural styles. The serene gardens and peaceful atmosphere make Lumbini a truly spiritual experience.

DAY 6

Lumbini -Pokhara

From Lumbini, you will drive to Pokhara, a journey of about 7 to 8 hours. Along the way, you'll pass through scenic landscapes and charming villages. Upon arrival in Pokhara, check into your hotel and enjoy the evening by the lake or exploring the local market.

DAY 7

Pokhara

This day is dedicated to exploring Pokhara's natural beauty. You can visit Phewa Lake for boating, see the stunning views from Sarangkot, or explore the caves and waterfalls. Other attractions include the World Peace Pagoda and the Mountaineering Museum. The evening offers a chance to relax by the lake or enjoy local cuisine.

DAY 8

Pokhara -Kathmandu

Today, you will return to Kathmandu, a drive that takes about 7 to 8 hours. Along the way, you can stop at scenic spots or villages for refreshments. Upon arrival in Kathmandu, check into your hotel and spend the evening at leisure.

DAY 9

Patan -Swayambhunath

This day is dedicated to exploring the cultural and historical sites of Kathmandu Valley. You will visit Patan Durbar Square, known for its intricate carvings and temples, and Swayambhunath Stupa, one of the oldest Buddhist sites in the valley. The evening offers a chance to reflect on your journey or do some last-minute shopping.

DAY 10

Kathmandu -Departure

On your final day, you will have some time in the morning to relax or make any last-minute purchases. Then, you will be transferred to the airport for your international departure, bringing an end to your Nepal adventure.
